

Opening time and duty of care

The Preschool opens at 8:45am.

Staff are here at 8:30 am, this is our set up and prep time prior to opening the doors.

Pick up and end of session times

Please ensure you are on time to pick up your child, staff have limited hours to clean and tidy at the end of the day.

Bus Service

A bus service is available to pick up and drop off your child after the completion of their preschool session. Please let staff know if you are interested, bus forms are available for you to fill out.

Sign in and Sign out

Please ensure you sign and write the time your child enters and leaves the preschool. Please support your child to find, write or trace their name.

Notices

Check your child's notice pocket daily for notices, school newsletters and other important correspondence. The notice pockets are in the main entrance. Information is also shared using the SeeSaw information sharing app.

Lunch Boxes

Fruit and water are the only food and drinks provided at preschool. If your child needs breakfast or lunch, please let the preschool staff know. When packing your child's lunch please ensure healthy food choices, if you require any information or lunchbox ideas please see Tink.

Spare clothes

Please bring a spare set of clothes in case of accidents; also, during warmer weather we will increase our water play experiences. Please let staff know if you do not want your child to play with water.
